Must enjoy interacting with the public, be enthusiastic and have water safety/boating experience such as lifeguarding, swim instruction, or other water related training/skills.

Key responsibilities:

- Travel throughout Victoria and the Capital Regional District to deliver public education through informational tables, media and demonstrations at community events, beaches, lakes, and marinas.
- Interact with the public in a professional and friendly manner
- · Be well-versed in water/boating safety and Lifesaving Society programs
- Provide a high level of knowledge and enthusiasm for water safety
- Create and post WaterWise social media
- Keeping regular logs and providing reports as required
- Performing regular checks of event equipment and team vehicle to ensure proper working order, reporting deficiencies to the Coordinator and/or Executive Director, and protecting the assets of the Lifesaving Society through appropriate use of equipment
